The following checklist is simply a guide to provoke thought and consideration about age-friendly features from a business point of view.

Getting To Your Business Sidewalks, Entrances

 $\hfill\square$ Are well maintained, accessible and free from obstructions

 $\hfill\square$ Have wheelchair sloped entry ramps that are non slip

 \Box Are well lit and signs are easy to read

□ There is prompt snow removal and care is taken to guard against ice build up

Parking

□ Parking lots are clear of snow and kept ice free to prevent falling

□ Available parking is well maintained and located nearby

□ Drop off and pickup areas available and conveniently located, obstruction free and clearly marked

□ There are sufficient handicap accessible parking spots

Getting Into Your Business Buildings

□ Entrance doors are easy to open for all ages and people with walkers or wheelchairs

□ There are automatic doors with buttons and timed to stay open properly

□ Flooring is non-slip

□ Wheelchairs are able to navigate aisles and spaces in your business

□ There are no or as few stairs as possible inside or outside or there are elevators and ramps available

□ Washrooms are on the main floor and can accommodate wheelchairs

 $\hfill\square$ Stairs are safe and have railings

 $\hfill\square$ There is sufficient seating

Employees in Your Business

□ Seniors and Youth are equally encouraged to seek employment. When using newer technologies staff are provided with appropriate training
