
Boreal Shores Art Tour

The Boreal Shores Art Tour is a free, self-guided driving tour featuring individual artist studios and group artist locations throughout Eastern Manitoba. Divided into three colour-defined regions, the studios and group locations are indicated by coloured dots with stop numbers in them. Group locations are further defined by letters designating each artist at the stop.

The Tour is an adventure and, like any good adventure, presents a mixture of surprises and challenges. The locations are a combination of old and new, public and private spaces. Some are easy to get into \$\ddot\text{c}\$ others have lots of stairs \$\hat{\gamma}_{\text{r}'}(7)\$. Some have washrooms available \$\begin{array}{l}\text{others do not.} \end{array}\$ (Wheelchair accessibility is varied, so please call ahead for information.)

From MB #59 turn west on MB #12 - go 6.7 km to Grand Marais. The Community Central building is on the right.








Chris Ford
